SUBJECT: How to configure the Point to Indexed Image Field

In this technote we will teach how to set the Point to Indexed Image feature on ID-ALL.

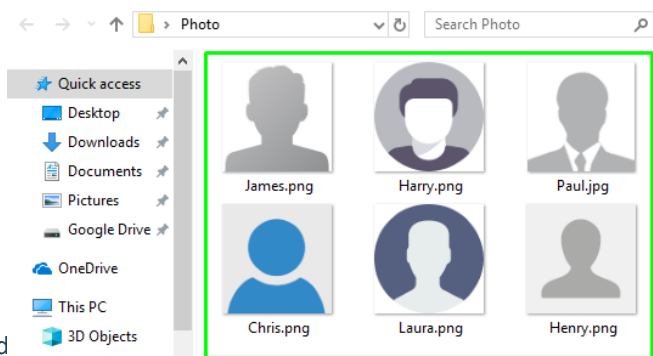
This feature enables you to link a photo folder to your database through the software.

So on the database you can add an additional field for the “Photo” or use an existing one.

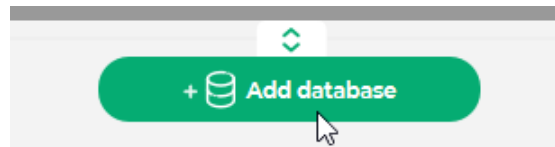
And on that column we need to have the same name as we have on the photos, so it can pull the correct image for each person/object.

Refer to the images below for an example.

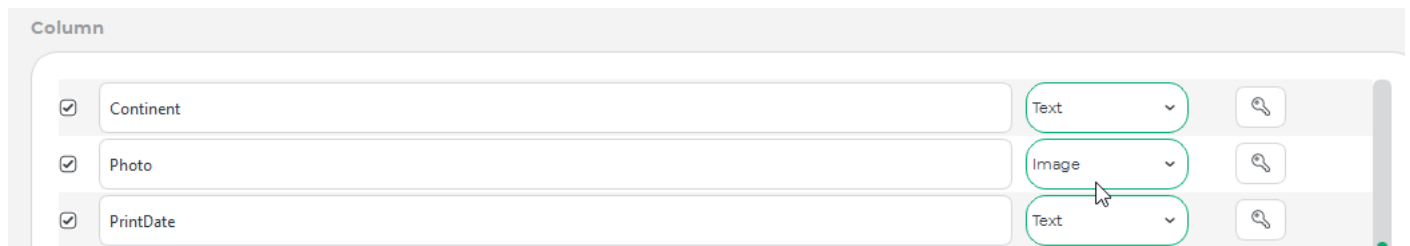

After that go to the software and reconnect your database, so locate the database document again so it searches for the new field.



Now make sure that in database connection you have that field set with the “Image” format.



Next, double-click the database image field, as the “Photo” field example in the image below.

If by default your images are in our “**Documents->Pictures**” folder, then they should automatically appear in the “My Image Folder” tab.

If not, you can select the “**Browse Image**” option to select the folder where the images are saved.

Or, you can also add an image from a specific URL (if it is not written in the database).

After that, close the Indexed Image Editor, then click on the “Refresh” button, to load the images.
