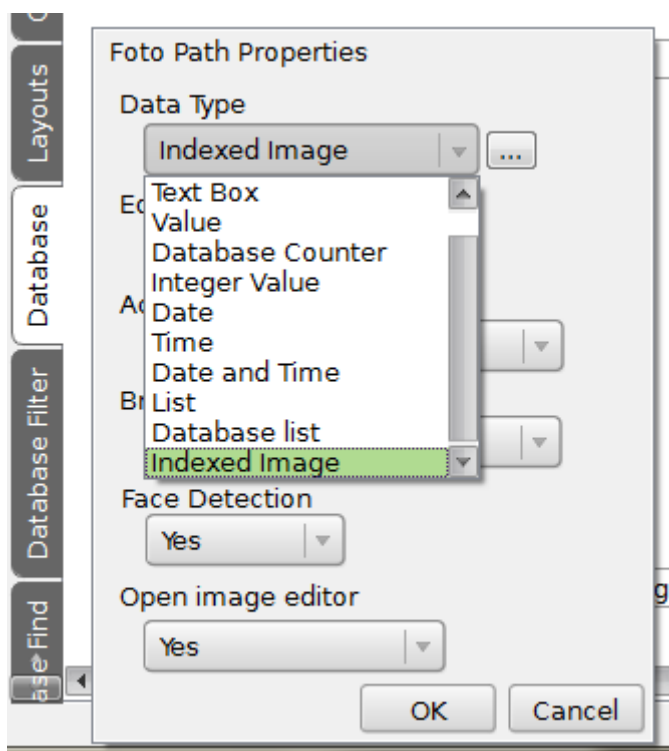

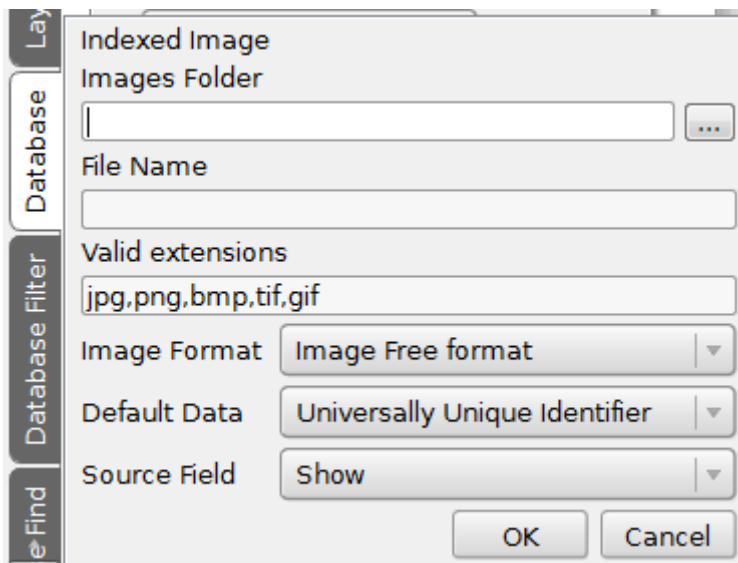
Subject: Link Image to Database Field

This technote explains how to link an image to a database field through its path in order to show the images on cardPresso's database area.

In cardPresso's database tab, right click on the name of the database field that contains the image path to open the menu depicted on the image below. Open the Data Type drop down and select Indexed Image. On the field Acquire, select from the drop down the option From Disk.



Next, click the button to the right of the drop down to open the menu below. Search for the folder with the images you plan on using and press ok.



Press ok again to close the properties menu and refresh your database connection as prompted. As of now, you should be able to see the image associated with each record on the image field.

If the extension of the images isn't listed among the **Valid extensions** you can add the manually, such as ".jpeg.svg". Please note that for images with several layers, they have to be flattened to the same layer, such as in the case below.
