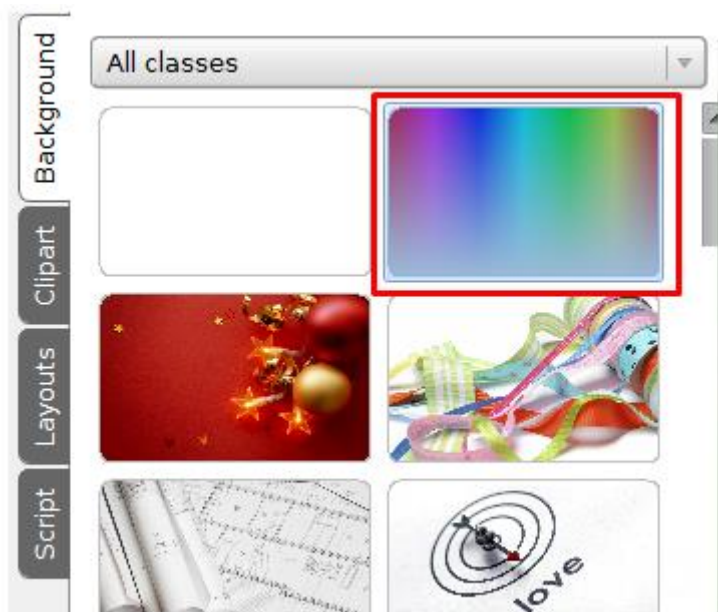

Subject: Using RGB color codes in the card layout

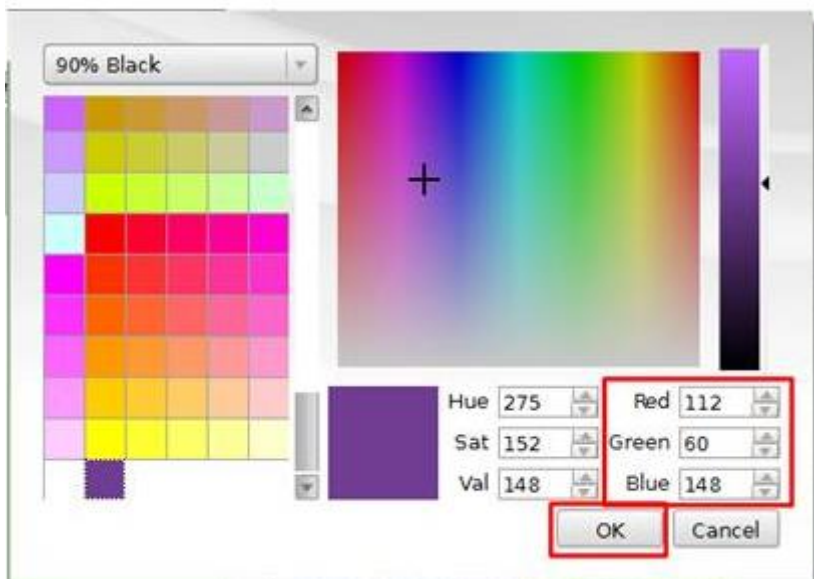
This technote describes how to use RGB color codes in your card design.

BACKGROUND

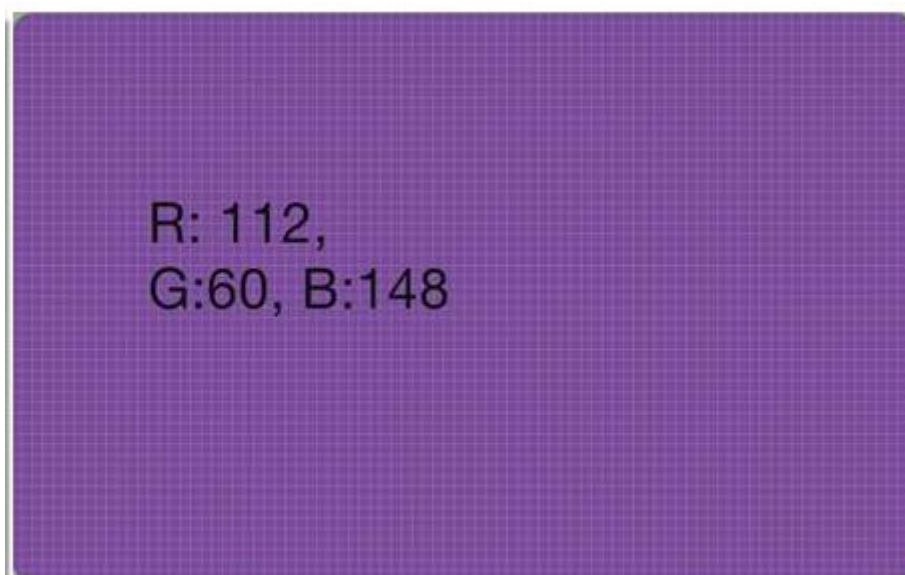
First, select the color pallet:



Next, enter the RGB (Red=R, Green=G and Blue=B) color code as highlighted:

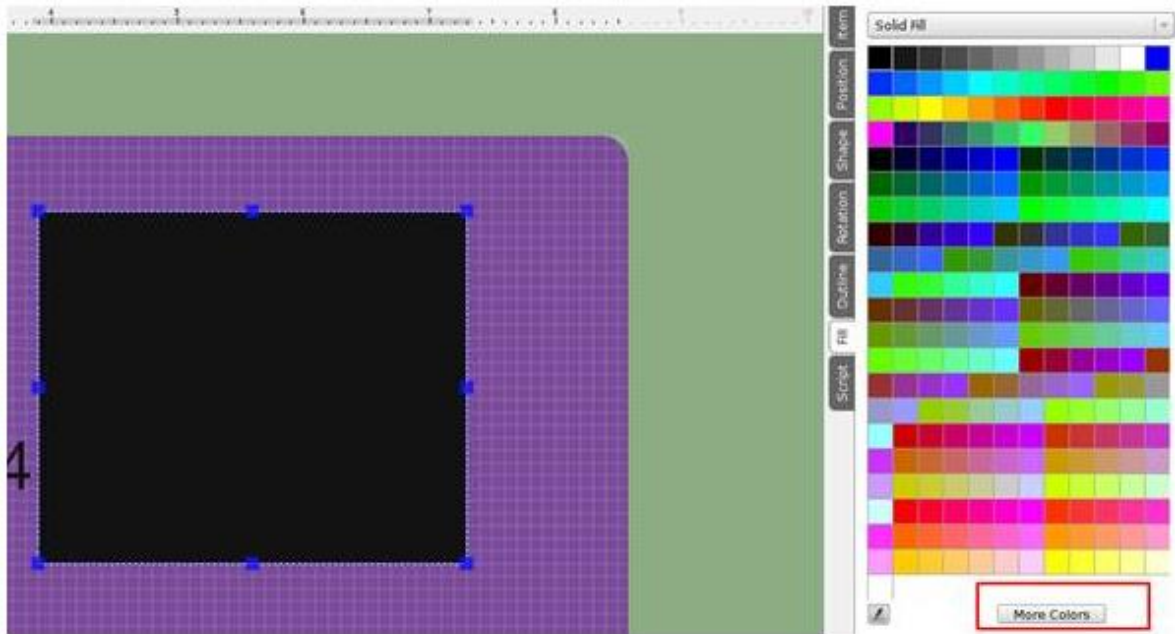


After inserting the code in the print screen above, you will get this color as the background of your card layout:

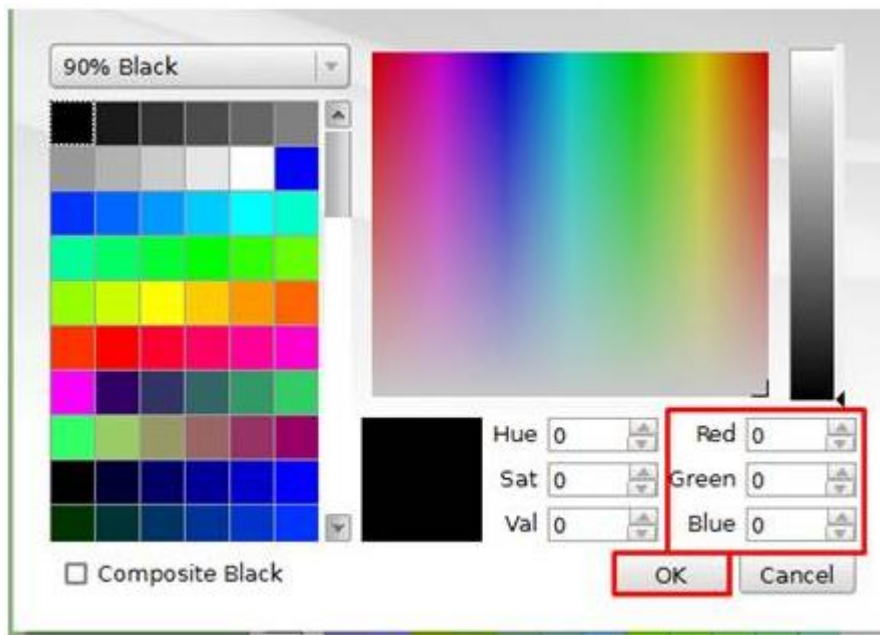


SHAPES

Place the Shape object intended in the card's layout, go to the **Fill** tab and click the button **More Colors**.

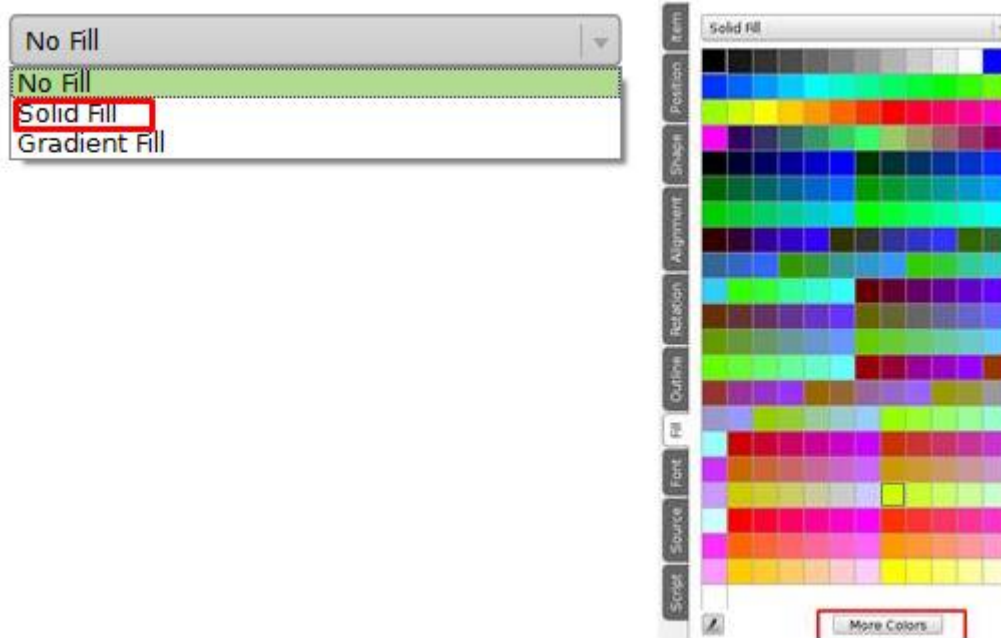


Change the **RGB** code for what you need.



TEXT

To change the font color, go to the **Fill** tab, change from **No Fill** to **Solid Fill**, and click the button **More Colors**.



Next, enter the **RGB** code.
